You owe a number of people amends. I have not shared the issues with them yet and hope you will humble yourself and deal with them. If not, they will be shared and it will be up to them whether or not they chose to follow any legal recourse as it relates to slander or liable. I do not fully understand your rebelliousness or your need to take your personal hurt out on people who have worked through a rehabilitative process. But, I do hope you will come to your senses and make some changes.

I will, if you choose, discuss these issues with you.
